Many of the poorest families in Cambodia live in remote rural areas where, although there are Primary Schools, there are hardly any Secondary or High Schools: these are located mostly in the towns.

**BUT.....**

With no public transport system, access to the town means a long walk down dirt roads which are often impassable in the raining season.

This severely restricts access to education beyond the most basic level and prevents young people achieving the grades they need for university or training.

The bikes will be presented in October, ready for the new school year starting in November. These 20 bikes will be distributed by the **Jesuit Refugee Service** in Svay Sisophon, close to the Thai border and will enable children living in the vast rural hinterland around Sisophon to access the wonderful new Xavier Jesuit School just outside the town.
