PROJECTS COMPLETED SINCE MARCH THIS YEAR.....

"NO BIKE, NO EDUCATION, NO FUTURE" was certainly taken to heart by the record number of people from all over North Norfolk [and beyond] who supported our 7th Annual Plant Sale at North Walsham on May 19th. With hundreds of quality plants at low prices, many generously donated by local nurseries and

private growers, Bake, Produce & Craft Stalls and 'The Great Wedding Cake Raffle' [thanks Veronique Cornish for making and donating this] an astonishing £2000 was raised, over double the original target. This is enough to fund 50 bikes, 30 of them in Banteay Meanchey Province, widely regarded as the poorest province in the country, The remaining 20 will be distributed in other centres when the need arises.

OTHER PROJECT NEWS IN BRIEF The Soups & Slides Lunch in March was sold out [get your tickets early in 2019!] and raised £1000 to provide a Community Building for Pheasabao Village in Pailin Province [picture page 1] This is now complete and in use. We are also supporting the villagers' aim to set up a community Vegetable Garden in the village. Our 7th borewell, at Day So Primary School, is complete and in action, largely thanks to the indomitable 'Gorleston Ladies'. Work on the Marketing Outlet at CROAP near Pursat is now well under way [see our website for more on this]. The SUPPORT CAMBODIA contribution here is a borewell [our 8th], essential to the success of this ambitious project. Thanks especially to private donors from Suffolk for their contribution.

Another very generous private donation has meant the **new flooring** at **Tampung Student Centre** near Battambang is finally finished.. and very smart it looks too. There was just enough left over to also provide a **slide projector and screen** for the Centre. Support for **food programmes** run by **Sisters Maria and Franny [Pursat]** and repairs to **St Sebastian Centre [Pongro]** have also been sent and the Trustees were very pleased to finally [after 12 months and much effort from **Brother Joseph Lieu**] finish the **water connection at Chomcatamau** near Kompong Chhnang. It's a tiny community and a tiny project but one which will make all the difference to health and quality of life: "small money, big difference' has never been so true
