## 1. WALKING THE CAMINO FOR CAMBODIA

Gorleston's indefatigable walker, Moira Selvage, has been at it again! This time, a



challenging 658k in 29 days along the Ignatian Camino from Loyola to Manresa. Sponsored by a large number of friends, associates and Gorleston parishioners in aid of the Support Cambodia Annual Appeal, it was truly a 'walk of love' for needy Cambodians. A few of Moira's impressions:

" Picturesque mountains in the Basque Region climbing in rain, lightning, mists; the luscious fruit and nut farms of Navarra; the daunting Cantabrian mountain range (and the mud!); flourishing grape vines in La Rioja; through the semi desert region of the Monegros in an unbearable 33c; walking on a variety of paths, forests, stone, asphalt, beside railway lines and highways; along the mighty River Ebro and the long Imperial Canal ; appreciating the stunning Mudejar architecture in Alagon; Catalunya with its stupendous range of mountains in Monserrat, climbing to 1258m for breathtaking panoramic views: and finally, to Manresa with its Ignatian presence. Mission accomplished – thanks be to God".

A wonderful achievement and especially fitting as so many of SVPPORT <AMBODIA'S friends and distributing partners in Cambodia are Jesuits, descendents in faith of St. Ignatius himself. Very well done... and thank you Moira. *Pictures on our Facebook Page.*
