Following the Meeting of the Trustee Board on Thursday June 18<sup>th</sup>, the following changes have been agreed:

### 1. Changes to the Trustee Board

Following the death of Treasurer **Robert Maidment** the following actions have been taken:

- **David Patrick** has accepted the position of Treasurer
- **Katie Maidment** will remain as Chair of Trustees.
- **Carol Shippey** will remain as the third Trustee.
- **Fran Ludden and Susie Thomson** have been invited [and have accepted] to be co-opted members of the Trustee Board and to attend all Trustee meetings with equal voting rights. They will not be formally registered as Trustees.
- The Charity Commission have been informed of the changes to the Trustees but not the co-opted members as this is not legally necessary.
- These 5 named persons will in future be known as The Trustee Board.

### 2. Who is responsible for what:

**3. Future Operation:** for a number of practical reasons including the impact of the pandemic on incoming funds, the Trustee Board have unanimously agreed that in order to remain effective, the charity needs to:

**A. Limit it's geographical spread** within Cambodia. Our main operation will therefore mainly focus on

- remote rural areas in Pailin Province
- villages within approximately 90 minutes of Battambang
- the Taom/Anlung Sa area outside Siem Reap.



**B. Concentrate funding** on locations *receiving no other NGO help*, with the aim of meeting essential needs for the very poorest communities taking priority. As a rule, sustainable, "small money, big difference" project applications will be considered ahead of major expenditure.

**4. The Coin Jar & Collection Tin** schemes will continue as they are very useful forms of regular income for the charity. All those holding Jars or Tins are encouraged to promote them in your local area and encourage others to maybe take up one or other of the schemes.
