Can't afford to feed your baby?

A story from Filipino missionary **Betty Millena** in Siem Reap: a baby...similar to this little boy....ten months old...his dad has left....and his mum can't afford to buy him milk

It's one of the most distressing problems facing women in very poor rural communities in Cambodia.

The situation has been exacerbated during the pandemic by loss of earnings, reduction in food supplies and family break-up, plus the effect of adverse weather over the last few months. An 800g tin of formula milk in Cambodia currently costs just under £10 and feeds a baby for a month. The monthly wage for an unskilled rural worker is around $\pm 50/\pm 60$ - provided the family has an income source at all.



Sister Vangie in Pailin tells us she currently has more mothers coming to ask for milk than she can help.

So although it's not strictly a 'community' project, more a matter of survival, Support Cambodia are intending to use money from our Nutrition and Women's Health Funds to help the situation where we can.

News in Brief

Emergency Flood Appeal

The remaining **£3,760** from the **Emergency Flood Appeal** has now been distributed, the bulk of it via **Brother Francis (Pailin)**, to assist more farmers than anticipated, to begin replanting their crops and the rest for food packs in rural villages in **Siem Reap** and **Pailin** Provinces. Thank you again to all who contributed to the final Appeal total of **£9,117.88** – a truly astonishing result which has helped so many people in real need.



Nikum Borewells

After much delay due to Covid-19, the repairs to two old **borewells in Nikum** have now been done. Formally opened and blessed by parish priest **Father Rajat Hassapurti** at a ceremony on 27th December, the wells finally bring a permanent water supply to 400 families in the central part of the Nikum district.



Reedonkao Toilets

A year after our last visit, the new toilet block at **Reedonkao** near Battambang is nearly complete. This follows on from the borewell put in by **Support Cambodia** in 2019/20 and which has made such a difference to the health of this very poor farming village. Huge thanks to **Vary Nivaa** and **Brother Francis** for their untiring help in bringing this project to fruition.
