Beatriz [Betty] Millena

Betty writes:

"My name is **Beatriz Millena [Betty]** and I am a lay missionary associate of the Foreign Missionary Society of Quebec. I come from the southern part of the Philippines but I've been here in Cambodia for about 22 years now, serving the Cambodian people.

I am a midwife by profession. After graduating from the midwifery course, I was involved in a particular programme for tribal people who live upland back home. I was helping and giving special training for the traditional midwives related to good hygiene and safe delivery in the village. For 6 years it was a beautiful and fulfilling experience and I was so happy and contented with the life I had at that time. But this made me reflect on how I could continue serving people and also share my love and compassion for the betterment of the life of the people. That is why I followed my desire and the Will of God to become a missionary.

For the first 8 years here in Cambodia, I accompanied and helped HIV pregnant mothers and children. It was one of my most fulfilling missionary works and I'm sure the best time of my life as a missionary in Cambodia. Then I was assisting sick children in paediatric hospitals particularly in **Takeo Province** in the south of the country.

At the same time, I was involved with a basic nutrition program in the villages of Takeo with the Daughters of Charity sisters and accompanying cancer patients in a health centre run by the Catholic Church in Phnom Penh.



After a year's break, I was invited by **Fr. Totet Banaynal, SJ** to help the pastoral work in **Siem Reap** parish. Currently, I am in charge of the group of women in the villages, organising workshops for health education and also in assisting sick and poor people in the parish.

My life is so blessed! I am so grateful to God for the right decision I made and truly it has been God's call for my entire life. No regrets, just grateful and fulfilled. It's a beautiful feeling to get involved in the life of others especially those who are really in need."

For several years, **Support Cambodia** has been helping Betty's work through our Women's Health Fund, providing formula milk, toiletries, underwear, Hygiene Bags and funding for her women's education classes. See 'A Late Christmas Present' below for more on this.

News from Cambodia



Cambodia's success in vaccinating its population [81% as at 1st January] has meant a return to relatively normal life with schools, places of worship and shops reopening, movement around the country allowed and tourists encouraged, subject to double vaccination and negative testing.

As Cambodia begins to come out of the pandemic, Father Carlos is restarting his youth initiative in Pailin. This involves the setting up of a football team and a dance group to encourage the youth to come together with the many benefits that come from social interaction. To get the scheme up and running, a UK donor has agreed to fund 15 football strips – thank you. If anyone else would like to contribute directly to this youth initiative via Support Cambodia, please get in touch.



- With the lifting of restrictions, **Sister Vangie** is now able to get out to the villages around **Pailin**. She says the farmers are starting to replant and so there will be a need for microfinance, but it will take a little time for a full assessment of what is required for these remote communities to get back on their feet. In the meantime we have provided funding for toiletries and assured Vangie of our willingness to help where we can.
- Originally scheduled for October 2021 but delayed due to Covid-19, work on the three Support Cambodia borewells in the Nikum area was finally due to start on January 20th. Details of this project may be found in the Autumn issue of Mango News available on the website.
- A number of people have asked "When are you going back to Cambodia?". The brief answer is "As soon as we can safely travel in both directions and get around the country". With the Covid situation as it is in Europe, that is not possible at present without a great deal of red tape, paperwork and expense. So

we must wait.....but we'll be back.....and we're so looking forward to seeing all our Cambodian friends once more.
