As UK-based **'SUPPORTERS'** will have read in the June Update, the charity's latest major project, the **THE SEWING CENTRE in PAILIN**, has now been open since May and the trainees are becoming more proficient and confident as each week passes. Having made hundreds of shirts, the ladies are now moving on to school uniform trousers and skirts.

Sister Vangie says that all the trainees "can [now] cut and sew already, not yet so perfect but it is a good start. Hopefully they can start to cut the students' uniform the following week. This week the trainer was sick so she need a week rest. Hopefully she will be back next week. Even if the teacher is not there, all of them come to continue to learn - they teach each other."

Bob Maidment Vocational Training

Our next project, to be launched in the autumn, will give selected young people from Pailin Province the opportunity to acquire practical skills [eg: mechanics, carpentry, beauty care, tourism etc.] together with basic entrepreneurship, management and accounting. Using contributions given in memory of our former Trustee **Bob**Maidment following his death in April 2020, this scheme is designed to give opportunities to students from poor, rural families who otherwise would not be able to afford this sort of training. It's a very fitting tribute to Bob, who had such a good rapport with teenagers and young adults.

In a way, this is a natural development from the **Sewing Centre** [above] and **Support Cambodia** will once again be working closely with **Father Carlos, Sister Vangie** and this time, also with the **Marist Education Centre** - a collaboration that will also benefit the many community programmes run by our contacts in the Pailin area.

HOW IT WILL WORK:

- Course length: mostly two years
- Cost: approximately £500-£750 per student per year [variable according to the course/ location and whether accommodation is needed]
- **Number of students per year:** initially two, rising to three in the second year.
- **How they will be selected:** personal recommendation, a strong work ethic and final exam results.
- When it will start: selection of students in November 2022 to start January 2023
- Who will oversee it: Sister Vangie, Father Carlos and the Marist Education Centre
- Student contribution: variable according to what each

family can afford but the students are encouraged to put something back into the local community upon completion of their studies.

For example, **Chan Nan** [banking & finance] and **Chrok Man** [agriculture] have both been working on Sister Vangie's community projects during their final year at college.

The Vocational Training scheme is intended to be an ongoing project in Bob's memory and although funding for the first year is obviously in place [thanks to the generosity of those who contributed in 2020], we need to ensure this funding continues well beyond the first two years.

From the Trustees...

The far-reaching effects of Covid-19, the war in Ukraine, a huge rise in the cost of living and UK society's increasing focus on themselves rather than on the wider world has had a serious impact on all charities, including **Support Cambodia**. Probably for similar reasons, communication with many of our previous Cambodian contacts is much reduced so we are no longer receiving project requests from some long-standing centres. The exceptions have been **Pailin** and **Siem Reap** who kept in touch throughout the very difficult days of lockdown and these are the centres where the majority of donated money has been spent in the last two years.. So, in order to ensure the effective continuation of the charity, and taking all the evidence into account, the Trustees have made the difficult but necessary decision to **restrict the charity's area of operation to just two areas of Cambodia:**

- 1. Pailin Province
- 2. Betty Millena's projects around Siem Reap.

With immediate effect, applications from other centres will only be considered in exceptional circumstances, and then only on an individual basis.

We feel this move will enable us to maintain not only accountability to our donors but also the close personal relationship with our Cambodian contacts - two factors central to the success of **Support Cambodia** over the last 7 years.
